What it is: The rule or reign of God (Matt. 6:33) in the hearts of believers (Lk17:21 "the kingdom of God is within you,) and finally over all peoples (Phil. 2 – "every knee will bow/tongue confess that Jesus is Lord.")

- Announced- (arrival of Jesus, fulfilling O.T. promise of Messiah)
 - o Mk. 1:15 Jesus proclaimed it.
 - Jh. 8:37 Jesus declared it to Pilate.
- Advancing (the church age present)
 - o Matt. 24:24
- **Arriving** –(future consummation His reign fully established)
 - o Rev. 11:15
 - o I Cor. 15:24
